There are two basic ways to organize the body of your paper.

How to Write a Comparative Analysis

The purpose of a compare and contrast essay is to analyze the differences and/or the similarities of two distinct subjects. A good compare/contrast essay doesn't only point out how the subjects are similar or different (or even both!). It uses those points to make a meaningful argument about the subjects.

How to Write a Compare and Contrast Essay (with Pictures)

Articles are reviewed by an editor, but not by a panel of experts: Articles have footnotes and bibliographies: Articles may or may not mention sources in the text: Minimal advertising, graphics, or illustrations unless relevant to the article (for example, art journals) Extensive advertising, lavish photos, colorful cover to market the magazine

One of the most common is the comparison/contrast essay, in which you focus on the ways in which certain things or ideas—usually two of them—are similar to (this is the comparison) and/or different from (this is the contrast) one another.

To compare two research journal papers, you would have to explore similarities and differences between the two papers. For example, your field is political science, one paper may be about Hitler, and the other paper may be about Stalin, or one is about Camus and the other paper is about Fanon.
