While the previous studies have explained the theoretical applications of experiential learning in entrepreneurship (e.g. Pittaway and Cope (2007), Politis and Gabrielsson (2009) and Corbett (2005)), this study build the alternative approach by integrating (1) Experiential Learning Theory and (2) Opportunity Evaluation Theory together, to serve as an alternative theory that increase entrepreneurial intention (Table 1).
