The city's inhabitants were slaughtered without distinction of age, sex or religious identity. A monk reported Arnald-Amaury saying, when asked how the Catholic citizens could be distinguished from the Cathars: 'Kill them all, God will recognise His own.' After being thoroughly looted, the city was set on fire and burned to the ground.
