Merger control is the third pillar of EU competition law. At EU level the Commission plays the central role in the control of concentrations. Subject to judicial review by the General Court and the ECJ the Commission decides whether a merger notified by the interested parties may be implemented.

Mergers which meet the turnover thresholds set by the EU merger control regulation (Regulation Nr 139/2004 or “EUMR”) will be governed by the EUMR (France being a Member State of the European Union).
