### **The New Privacy**

Relief was to be administered by a group of overseers, who were to assess a compulsory property tax, known as the poor rate, to assist those within the parish "having no means to maintain them." The poor were divided into three groups: able-bodied adults, children, and the old or non-able-bodied (impotent).
