One may speculate that the current interest in the genetic diversity and vulnerability of crop plants was brought about by the United States' experience with corn leaf blight in 1969 - 1970 (Brown, 1983). During 1970, a previously unknown race of *Helminthosporium maydis* destroyed approximately 15% of the U.S. corn crop.
