• Has a basic understanding of some key principles of teaching, learning and assessment. • Can plan and deliver simple lessons with a basic awareness of learners' needs, using core teaching techniques. • Can use available tests and basic assessment procedures to support and promote learning.

A child's first teacher is their parent. Children are often exposed to their earliest math skills by their parents. When children are young, parents use food and toys as a vehicle to get their children to count or recite numbers.

The key features of classroom tasks for young language learners are: They have coherence and unity for learners (from topic, activity and/or outcome). They have meaning and purpose for learners. They have clear language-learning goals.

Methods and Techniques for Young Learners - Professor Jack ...

The passive view of teaching views the learner as 'an empty vessel' to be filled with knowledge, whereas constructivism states that learners construct meaning only through active engagement with the world (such as experiments or real-world problem solving).

Constructivism as a Theory for Teaching and Learning ...

Effective classroom learning tasks provide students the opportunities to extract meaning, expand language, notice how language is used, and take part in a meaningful interpersonal exchange. Meaningful communication occurs when students process content that is relevant, purposeful, interesting, and engaging.
