Now White normally recaptures with the b1-knight, with 4.Nxc3, since 4.Bc4 cxb2 5.Bxb2 e6, blocking out the bishop on c4, makes it very tough for White to demonstrate adequate compensation for two pawns.

The Morra gambit is a counter-Sicilian opening in which white responds to 1...c5 with 2.d4; traditionally this would follow with 2...cxd4 and then 3.c3. In this post I will not only be covering the traditional variation arising from 2...cxd4 but also side-lines I have personally faced (2...b6, 2...d6,2...nf6)
