### Construction of the National Archives Building

On each side of the National Archives Building in Washington, DC (on Pennsylvania and Constitution Avenues), sit two 65-ton statues. Each statue is more than 10 feet high and, with their bases, tower 25 feet above the sidewalk. They were carved from 1934 to 1935, and each came from a single piece of Indiana limestone.

One of the first steps to a National Archives building occurred on September 26, 1877, when yet another fire broke out, this time in the Patent Office Building (which had previously burned in 1836). The fire started on the top floor and destroyed over 80,000 models and 600,000 copy drawings.
